1. Tuition fees

Our annual tuition fees are paid via 11 monthly debit order instalments from February to December 2024, on the 1st day of each month.

Our tuition fees include: school camp, most extra-mural & cultural activities, general art/music/technology levies, school magazine

Our tuition fees exclude: personal text books & stationery, outings, individual music lessons, Cambridge Examination fees (gr 10-12)

2. Capital levy

A capital levy is due for each enrolled child and added to our "School Improvement Fund". The final levy amount will only be determined after 15 January 2024, depending on the level of voluntary donations received by the fund up until that date. But it **will not exceed R1,000 per child for 2024. The levy will be divided into 11 equal instalments and billed from February to December 2024, along with normal tuition fees.**

3. Admission fees:

(* the sibling application fee discounts above are valid for as long as at least 1 child from the family remains enrolled at the school)

Fees payable should your child join the School after the official start of the school year:

- If your child joins us at any time during January, the normal fee billing from February to December will apply.
- If your child joins us during the first 5 term time school days of any month thereafter, then 100% of the normal fee billing from that month onwards until December will apply, unless par 3 below applies.
- If your child joins us during the last 5 term time school days of any month after January, zero billing will apply for that month, and normal monthly billing will commence from the child's second calendar month at the school.
- If paragraphs 1 to 3 above do not apply, then you will be billed at 50% of the normal fee rate for the starting month, and normal monthly billing will commence from the child's second calendar month at the school.

Termination of your child's tuition at the School:

Should parents wish to withdraw a child from the School at any time prior to the end of their grade 12 year:

- Parents shall be obliged to give at least 1 calendar month's written notice ("notice period") of such termination, to the Headmaster/Headmistress. Notices of withdrawal received after the 1st of a month (for example, 2 February) will therefore extend the notice period to the last day of the following month (in this example, 31 March), regardless of the termination date requested by the parents.
- Upon such termination, parents shall be liable to the School for payment in respect of the fees owing to the School up to and including the last day of the notice period regardless of whether or not the child remains at the School during all or part of the notice period.
- Terminations effective on 31 January of any year will be liable for January fees at a rate equal to 1/12 of the annual fees, since January fees are usually collected between February and December of each year.

Interest on overdue accounts: fees are due by the 1st working day of each month. Overdue amounts shall bear interest at a rate equivalent to the prime bank rate charged by ABSA Bank as at the 1st day of the relevant month plus 3% and compounded monthly.
