- The applicant should have an applicable qualification for an Intermediate Phase class teacher.
- The applicant must be SACE registered.
- Be computer literate. HTML, CSS and Javascript and Google Workspace experience will be advantageous.

Key Responsibilities:

A. General class teacher duties:

- Teaching Grade 4 - 6 Coding (8 lessons per week spread over Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays)
- General classroom teacher duties.
